



George Di Ciero Scholarship

The George Di Ciero Scholarship was established to honor Mr. Di Ciero's long and dedicated service as City Manager of Broomfield, Colorado and his admiration for the academic excellence of the University of Colorado, his alma mater, and other Colorado universities. It is Mr. Di Ciero's desire that the winner of this scholarship pursue a course of study that will prepare him or her for a life of public service.

Eligibility:

- Must have resided within the city limits of Broomfield, Colorado for a minimum of 3 years prior to high school graduation (verifiable).
- Must be a candidate for high school graduation (any accredited Colorado high school) in the spring of the year applying.
- Show community service and extra-curricular activities participated in while in high school.
- **Must be accepted and enrolled at any Colorado college or university (provide acceptance letter with application).**
- Must demonstrate a strong interest in a career in public service (supplying an essential commodity or service for the benefit or welfare of people). This can include any professional staff position for city, county, government, non-profit, school, etc.

Applications will be reviewed by a committee with members from the Broomfield Community Foundation and representatives from the high schools located in Broomfield. Personal interviews, for those that pass the initial application review screening, may be included in the selection process.

Written notification of the Selection Committee's decision will be mailed to applicants in June. If the applicant's school has a senior awards ceremony, the scholarship will be announced at that time.

This scholarship payment will be sent directly to the selected college/university for application to the student's account for use only at the college/university for tuition purposes. The amount shall not exceed \$5,000 for an academic year. Should the student not attend or withdraw from school, unused funds must be returned to the Broomfield Community Foundation and the George Di Ciero Scholarship Fund. This scholarship is renewable for up to four years upon certified proof of a 3.0 GPA and successful completion of the past year's full-time course work.

In the event that the scholarship recipient fails to achieve the 3.0 accumulated grade point at the end of any given school year of receiving the scholarship, he/she will go on a one semester (two quarter) probation. If the 3.0 is again achieved at the end of the probation, the scholarship will be reinstated. If the 3.0 is not achieved at the end of the probation, or in a given year thereafter, the scholarship will be terminated.
