2013 Year in Review

Anniversary year turns out to be a big celebration

The Broomfield Community Foundation celebrated its 20th anniversary in 2013... and it was a BIG year.

The highlights included grants to 58 non-profit organizations in Broomfield, 10 scholarships, and 59 needs-referrals for a total of \$182,174.

This was the year that the Legacy Fund reached it's goal of \$1 million. The Legacy Fund is the Foundation's endowment. It was started in 1999 as a way to ensure that the the Foundation lives on. Now that the goal has been met, additional granting opportunities will be available.

Fundraising efforts and donations from Dancing with the Broomfield Stars and Colorado Gives Day surpassed the previous year.

"Overall, it was a wonderful year," said Karen Smith, executive director. "The Broomfield community gave with their hearts and allowed us to have several reasons to celebrate in 2013." ❤️
