Excitement is building!

It takes dreams to make the community better. One of these dreams began in 1999 when Jack TerHar, Jr. challenged Broomfield residents to create an endowment at the Broomfield Community Foundation. With that challenge, the Legacy fund was born. It was determined by the Board that \$1,000,000 would be the endowed principal.

Thanks to generous donor support in 2012, the Foundation Board recently approved a \$30,000 transfer from the general fund to the Legacy fund. We now need only \$60,000 to reach that minimum principal.

Why the excitement? Once the principal is established, a percentage of the earnings can be distributed each year to help non-profits and causes to improve

Broomfield. Think of the positive impact this growing endowment will have over the next 10, 20, 50 or even 100 years!
